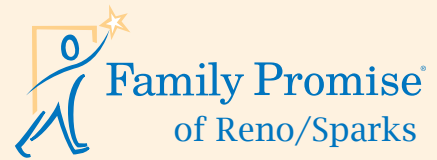


Annual Report

Our mission is to support families on their journey to a stable future.

We do this by engaging a community wide network of volunteers and services to secure interim housing, meals, and comprehensive assistance for families in transition.

Interfaith Hospitality Network Program (IHN):

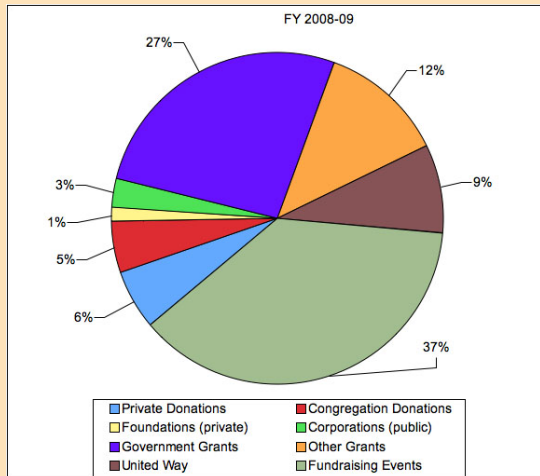
75% of families served by the IHN program transitioned from being without a home into permanent housing.

As the economy presented new challenges to families that sought to find employment and the confidence to transition into housing, the average length of stay in the IHN program went from 67 days in 2007-2008 to 96 days this past year.

However, the care that families who participate in the IHN program receive does not just end at shelter. Eleven of the 16 families served received support through the IHN aftercare program which seeks to help families maintain stability for years to come.

Each year over 9,000 miles are traveled taking families to and from host congregations, taking children to school and making sure parents get to important appointments.

Over 290,000 hours of volunteer time was contributed this last year to helping families regain stability.

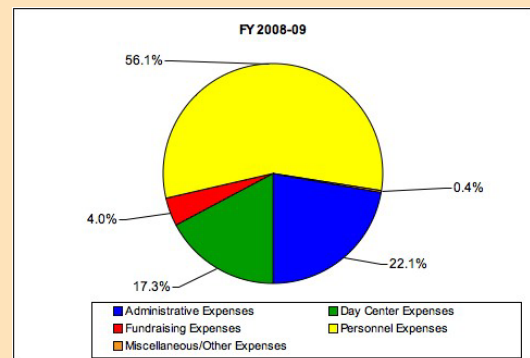
