23 families departed the IHN program between July 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008. 18 families (78%) moved out directly into permanent housing.

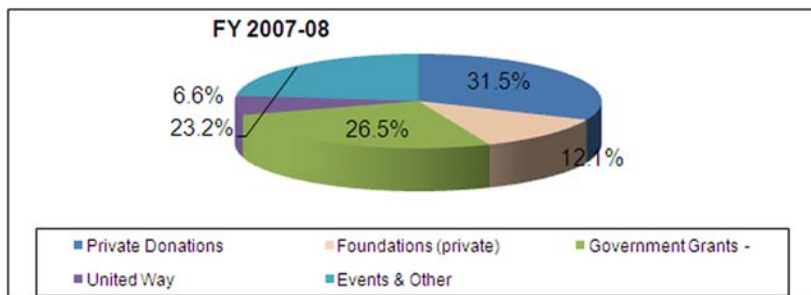
The average length of stay for a family in the IHN shelter program was 64 days.

The average age of a person served by the IHN shelter program between 2007-2008 was 16.

Over 9,500 miles were put on the Family Promise of Reno/Sparks van, transporting families to and from host congregations, the day center, school, work and important appointments.


